Over the coming weeks we will be visiting each Natural Sciences laboratory to inspect and review the protocols for handling, disposing, and securing these agents.

Laboratories on this floor are scheduled for inspection on APRIL 1, 2003, AT 6:30 PM. Please ensure that all persons with access to this facility are present at that time so that we may verify proper university identification and review important security procedures. We will do our best to ensure that the inspection process does not take more than two hours. Please specifically be ready to present objects including biological or chemical agents; stock of high-strength aluminum or other materials; and large magnets, such as those used in gas centrifuges.
