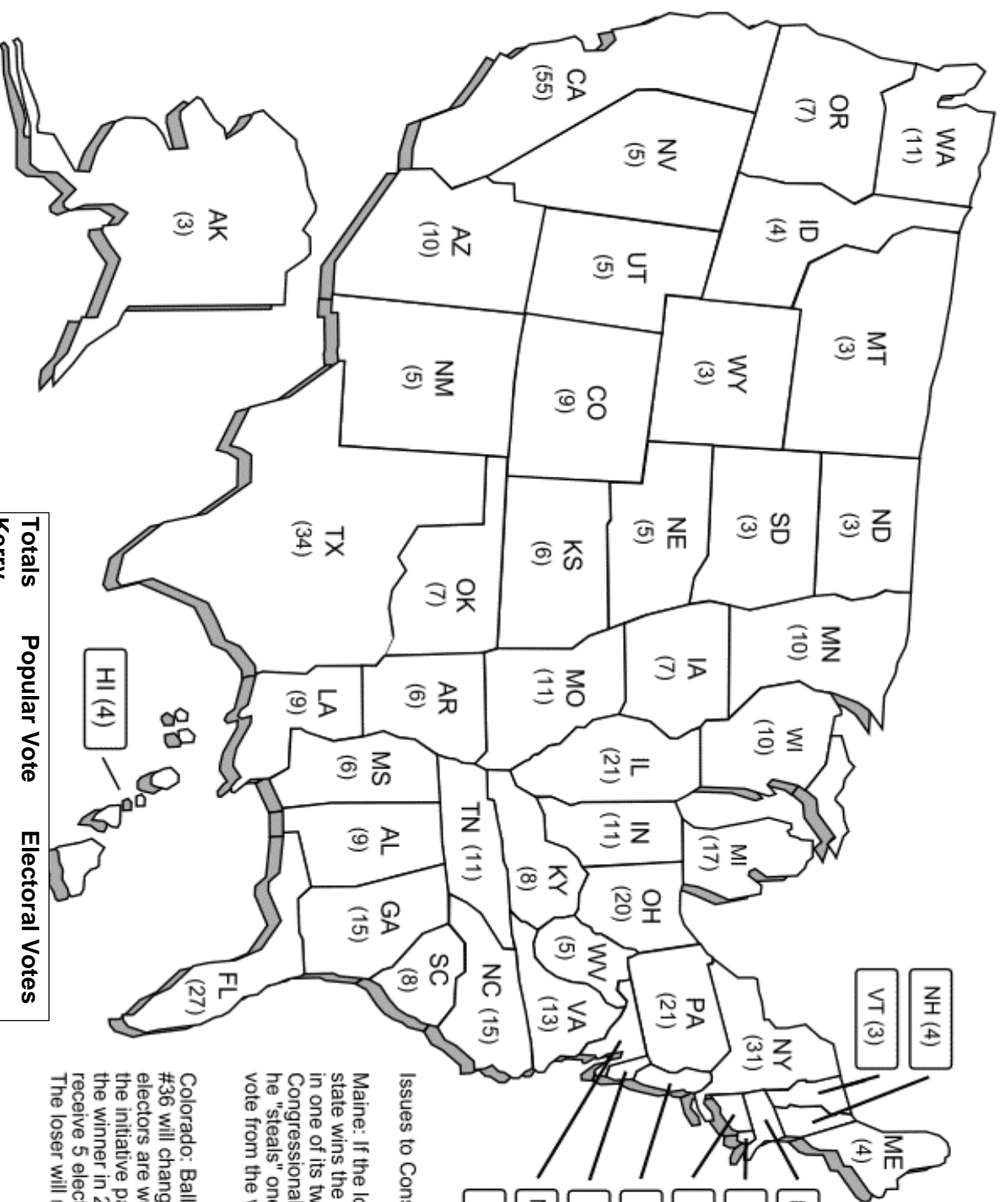

**Issues to Consider**

Maine: If the loser in the state wins the popular vote in one of its two Congressional districts, he "steals" one electoral vote from the winner.

Colorado: Ballot Initiative #36 will change how electors are won. If the initiative passes, the winner in 2004 will receive 5 electoral votes. The loser will receive 4.
